HOAs and Backyard Chickens

The recent Missouri law, HB 2062, introduces new opportunities for residents interested in keeping chickens. The new law allows homeowners with lots of 8,712 square feet or more to own and pasture up to six chickens.

This law also addresses the role homeowners' associations (HOAs) now hold, noting that they can no longer prevent residents from owning or pasturing chickens if their property meets this size requirement. However, residents should still coordinate with their HOAs regarding other elements of chicken keeping, such as coop design, placement, etc.

Wentzville's existing Code is already in line with this law, and we've established careful guidelines to ensure that chickens are kept responsibly. These guidelines are designed to protect both the health of our community and the well-being of our feathered friends.
